Specimen Collection | Clinical Pathology Laboratories

Anaerobic Culture: Be sure the specimen is from a suitable anaerobic sterile body site or a deep body cavity. Send a culture swab immersed in appropriate transport media. Submit promptly for optimal recovery of pathogens. Blood Cultures: Ideally, 20 mL of blood is drawn and split between an aerobic bottle and an anaerobic bottle.

When drawing multiple blood samples from a line, always draw the blood culture ...

Capillary puncture may be used for obtaining specimens in infants or in adults where venipuncture is difficult. Specimens from infants under the age of 6 months are typically collected by heelstick.

Specimen Collection for Serology (IgG) Testing. Collect at least 5 mL of blood in a plastic serum separator tube (SST). Gold top tubes with gel serum separator, preferred. Centrifuge the SST according to blood collection manufacturer's instructions for separation of serum from whole blood.

BLOOD CULTURE - bioMérieux

Blood culture: blood specimen submitted for culture of microorganisms. It enables the recovery of potential pathogens from patients suspected of having bacteremia or fungemia. Blood culture series: a group of temporally related blood cultures that are collected to determine whether a patient has bacteremia or fungemia.
